The term of each CLIN is defined in section F of the task order.

(b) In the event that the incurred level of effort exceeds by 5% or less of the task order requirement, but does not exceed the estimated cost of the task order, the Contractor shall be entitled to cost reimbursement for actual hours expended, not to exceed the ceiling cost. The Contractor shall not be paid fixed fee, however, on level of effort in excess of 100% without complying with subsection (d) below. This understanding does not supersede or change subsection (d) below, whereby the Contractor and Government may agree on a change to the task order level of effort with an equitable adjustment for both cost and fee.

(c) Either the "Limitation of Cost" or the "Limitation of Funds" clause, depending upon whether or not the task order is fully funded, applies independently and nothing in this clause amends the rights or responsibilities of the parties hereto under either of those two clauses. In addition, the notifications required by this clause are separate and distinct from any specified in either the "Limitation of Cost" or "Limitation of Funds" clause.

(d) The Contractor shall notify the Task Order Ordering Officer immediately in writing whenever it has reason to believe that:

- (1) The level of effort the Contractor expects to incur under the task order in the next 60 days, when added to the level of effort previously expended in the performance of the task order, will exceed 75% of the level of effort established for the task order; or
- (2) The level of effort required to perform the task order will be greater than the level of effort established for the task order.

As part of the notification, the Contractor shall provide the Task Order Ordering Officer a revised estimate of the level of effort required to perform the task order. As part of the notification, the Contractor also shall submit any proposal for adjustment to the estimated cost and fixed fee that it deems would be equitable if the Government were to increase the level of effort as proposed by the Contractor. Any such upward adjustment shall be prospective only; i.e., will apply only to effort expended after a modification (if any) is issued. However, whether an increase in fixed fee is appropriate shall depend on the circumstances involved, and, except as otherwise provided in the task order, shall be entirely within the discretion of the Contracting Officer. In no event, however, shall the fixed fee be increased unless the revised level of effort exceeds the previously established level of effort by more than 10%.

(e) In the event that less than 100% of the established level of effort, or if said level of effort has been previously revised upward, of the fee bearing portion of the additional hours by which the level of effort was last increased, is actually expended by the completion date of the task order, the Government shall have the option of;

(1) Requiring the Contractor to continue performance, subject to the provisions of the limitation of cost clause, or, as applicable, the limitation of funds clause, until the effort expended equals 100% of the original level of effort or of the fee bearing portion of the last upward revision; or

(2) Effecting a reduction in the fixed fee by the percentage by which the total expended man-hours is less than 100% of the original level of effort or the fee bearing portion of the last upward revision.

(f) Within thirty days after completion of the base period and each exercised option, the Contractor shall submit the following information

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in writing directly to the Task Order Ordering Officer, the TOM and the Defense Contract Audit Agency office to which vouchers are submitted.

- (1) The total number of man-hours of direct labor expended;
- (2) A breakdown of this total showing the number of man-hours expended in each direct labor classification utilized for performance, including the identification of the key employees utilized;
- (3) The Contractor's estimate of the total allowable cost incurred under the task order.
- (4) In the case of a cost underrun, the amount by which the estimated cost of the task order may be reduced to recover excess funds.

(a) The fixed fee, as specified in Section B of this contract, subject to any adjustment required by other provisions of this contract, will be paid in installments to be paid at the time of each provisional payment. 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SECTION C DESCRIPTIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

STATEMENT OF WORK

FLEET SUPPORT FOR SHIP ALTERATION INSTALLATIONS

1.0 BACKGROUND:

NUWC Division Newport is tasked with the installation of various ship alterations (SHIPALTs) and temporary alterations (TEMPALTs) on ships and submarines. These SHIPALT'S include the installation of the AN/BLQ-10 EW system and AN/BRD-7 replacement. To accomplish these tasks, services are required to procure and ship installation materials to the installation sites; provide manning and logistics to perform the installations; coordinate the return of specialized equipments; and return the installation platforms back to original condition.

2.0 SCOPE:

The scope of work of this task order includes, but is not limited to, the installations of various EW systems in LOS ANGELES, OHIO, and SEAWOLF class submarines. This SOW is for one year with the possibility of three, one year options.

The contractor shall provide SHIPALT / TEMPALT installation support services which includes the following:

- (1) Receive / obtain GFM installation kit materials. The contractor shall inspect materials and forward comments to NUWC Division Newport for action. Contractor shall also provide transportation services for delivery of GFM materials to job site(s).
- (2) Fabricate necessary consumable / installation materials required to support SHIPALT / TEMPALT installations. The contractor shall fabricate materials and assemble SHIPALT / TEMPALT Installation Kits.
- (3) Fabricate foundations, cabinets, cable assemblies, ventilation, lockers and other items in support of SHIPALT installations.
- (4) Provide necessary and qualified tradesmen, technicians, supervision, and management in support of SHIPALT / TEMPALT installations.
- (5) Provide welding, mechanical, and administrative Submarine Safety (SUBSAFE) services in support of SHIPALT installations.
- (6) Contractor shall support / attend meetings, conferences, program reviews, etc.

4.0 TASK REQUIREMENTS

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The contractor shall provide and maintain a Quality System that shall comply with the requirements of NAVSEA Standard Item 009-04, and which shall have been accepted by NAVSEA 04XQ or a SUPSHIP office. The prime contractor must be listed on the SEA04XQ "List of AIT Contractors and Government Activities with NAVSEA Approved Quality Systems".

The contractor shall provide verification of certification for welders and Non Destructive Testing (NDT) personnel and ensure that certified personnel carry a copy of their certification at all times while performing SHIPALTS on Government vessels or property.

The contractor shall provide and maintain process control procedures to comply with the requirements of NAVSEA Standard Items. The Government reserves the right, during the term of this contract, to request process control procedures for purposes of verifying compliance with this requirement.

The contractor shall perform tasks in accordance with the applicable documents listed in Section 3.0. The Contract Data Requirements List (CDRL) describes the deliverables that shall be expected under this task order.

4.1 Ship Alterations / Temporary Alterations Installations (SHIPALTS/ TEMPALTs)

The contractor shall perform installations of various SHIPALT's and TEMPALT's on-board SSN 688 Class, SSN 21 SEAWOLF Class, and SSBN / SSGN Trident Class Submarines. Installation shall include obtaining and delivering the installation kit (GFM), fabricating installation support materials (consumables and services), providing an installation team (tradesmen, technicians, and supervision), and performing the installation per the requirements of NSTS 9090-310D.

The contractor shall deliver Reports detailing equipment and material fabricated, in accordance with CDRL A001. The contractor shall deliver SHIPALT Installation Reports in accordance with CDRL A002.

The contractor shall generate Work Authorization Forms (WAFs), included in DOD/MIL Specifications (GFI), Re-Entry Control requests (RECs), Liaison Action Requests (LARs), and a copy of Ship Installation Drawings (SID'S) as installed redlines. The contractor shall deliver all Forms in accordance with CDRL A003.

The contractor shall provide a Plan of Action and Milestones(s) for each installation in accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement (GFI). The contractor shall also include a report of daily progress in accordance with the On-Site Government Representative Report (GFI).

The contractor shall deliver the Plan of Action & Milestones (POA&M) in accordance with CDRL A004. The contractor shall deliver a Daily Progress Report in accordance with CDRL A005.

4.2 Administrative Submarine Safety Services

The contractor shall provide services for welding or other work which fall under the Submarine Safety (SUBSAFE) Program. All services that fall within the SUBSAFE certification boundary are to be performed strictly in accordance with NAVSEA 0924-062-0010 (Latest Revision) Submarine Safety (SUBSAFE) Requirements Manual. Additionally, only activities listed in NAVSEA Note 5000 are authorized to perform work within the SUBSAFE certification boundary. A separate formal agreement will be established with parties involved to specifically address SUBSAFE work and testing requirements.

4.3 Planning Support and Ship-Checks

The contractor shall perform ship checks with respect to Ship Alteration Programs. The effort includes the fabrication of CFM, receipt and management of GFM/GFI, planning and pre-planning efforts for installation support. The contractor shall conduct engineering analyses and ship-checks to verify and validate Ship Installation Drawings (SID's) against each particular platform where the system will be installed. The contractor shall also attend technical meetings, pre-installation meetings, conferences, and program reviews (Schedule GFI) to gather information and make recommendations relative to installation planning, scheduling, and execution.

The contractor shall deliver Ship Check Reports in accordance with CDRL A006. The Contractor shall deliver

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Trip/Meeting Reports in accordance with CDRL A007.

4.4 Documentation Review, Evaluation and Validation

The contractor shall review, modify, verify, maintain and make improvement recommendations to SHIPALT's, SAR's, EC's and associated technical documentation (GFI). The contractor shall review installation documentation (GFI) for the purpose of determining whether the documentation conforms to ship and system specifications (GFI). The contractor shall provide comments and recommendations to NUWCDIVNPT.

4.5 Material Procurement and Pre-Fabrication

The contractor shall obtain, fabricate, assemble, and deliver foundation and mounting fixtures, incidental materials and tools to the required site(s). The contractor shall assemble, ship, and stage kits, units and components (GFE) to the required site(s). The specific hardware, components, and fixtures will be defined by GFI design specifications, installation plans and other data provided as GFI.

4.6 Monthly Progress and Financial Reports

The contractor shall deliver monthly cost and performance report in accordance with the basic contract clause, C16 COST AND PERFORMANCE REPORTING.

6.0 GOVERNMENT FURNISHED PROPERTY (GFP)

6.1 GOVERNMENT FURNISHED FACILITIES (GFF)

The contractor shall have access to a staging facility located at the piers, building 68, at NUWCDIVNPT. The contractor shall have access to GFF at other Government sites on a non-interference, and rent-free basis depending where installations and ship check are performed. For the Base Year only, the hardware, consumables, foundations, etc. are being purchased by the Government. This Material will be furnished to the Contractor as Government Furnished Material.

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7.0 PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The Period of performance shall be 48 months (including options).

8.0 PLACE OF PERFORMANCE

Work under this task order shall be accomplished at Naval Submarine Base New London, CT, Naval Undersea Warfare Center Newport, RI, Submarine Base Kings Bay, GA; Naval Station Norfolk, Norfolk, VA; Naval Submarine Base Pearl Harbor, HI; Naval Submarine Base Point Loma, San Diego, CA. and possibly at contractor facilities and other locations as needed.

10.0 ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

The work performed in this SOW does not involve the use of Active Sonar and therefore there is no environmental impact.

11.0 QUALITY SURVEILLANCE & PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

The Government will conduct quality surveillance via various methods including formal and informal meetings, review of technical reports, review of monthly progress reports, and review of deliverables. Contractor performance will be evaluated in the areas of technical quality, responsiveness, timeliness and cost. Technical quality will be evaluated against the performance standards and goals defined in the Statement of Work. Responsiveness will be evaluated based upon the Government experience interacting with the contractor during performance. Timeliness will be evaluated based on the contractor's ability to meet agreed upon schedules with minimal variance. Cost will be evaluated based upon the contractor's ability to manage to agreed costs.

H20S INSURANCE - WORK ON A GOVERNMENT INSTALLATION

This includes, but is not limited to, medical examinations; immunizations; passports, visas, etc. and security clearances. If any work will take place on a U.S. Navy vessel, the Contractor shall obtain boarding authorization for all contractor personnel from the Commanding Officer of the vessel. Authorization shall be obtained prior to boarding.

(b) The Government will reimburse the Contractor for allowable travel costs incurred by the Contractor in performance of the contract in accordance with FAR subpart 31.2 or 31.3 as applicable.

There may be situations where contractor employees and government employees travel together in government vehicles, or in vehicles rented by the government under the terms of the U.S. Car Rental Agreement (currently available at http://www.defensetravel.dod.mil/Docs/CarRentalAgreement_050508.pdf) the government has with various rental car companies.
